KINDERGARTEN

- Backpack with name on it (large enough to hold folders, a blanket, and a complete change of clothes)
- Blanket - small blanket that fits in tote bag (needed only for those staying for afternoon childcare)
- Change of clothes
- Tissues - 1 large box

GRADES 1 AND 2

- Art Box (5 x 8 inch) – to accommodate all art supplies (scissors, pencils, crayons, etc.)
- Backpack (large enough to accommodate binder and several books)
- Bible – King James Version
- 1 Container of disinfectant wipes (ex. Clorox)
- Crayola Crayons - 1 box of 24 colors
- Dry erase marker – black (replace as necessary)
- Flash Cards (for home use)
 - 1st grade - addition and subtraction
 - 2nd grade – addition, subtraction, multiplication
- Folders – 2 folders with pockets (plastic folders are highly recommended)
- Glue Sticks – 4 large
- Pencils – 10 #2 standard pencils
- Scissors – blunt ends only (we recommend Fiskars); buy lefties for left-handed students
- Tissues – 3 large boxes

GRADES 3 AND 4

- Art Box (8 x 11 inch)
- Backpack (large enough to accommodate binder and several books)
- Bible – King James Version
- 1 three-ring binder - 1 inch
- 1 Book Cover (fabric works best) – 4th grade only
- Colored Pencils – at least 12 basic colors
- 1 Container of disinfectant wipes (ex. Clorox)
- Crayons - 1 box of 24 colors
- 5 Pocket Dividers (for binder)
- Dry erase eraser
- 2 Dry erase markers – black (replace as necessary)
- Erasers – 2 large pink style
- Flashcards – multiplication and division (for home use)
- Folders – 3 folders with pockets (plastic folders are highly recommended)
- Glue Sticks - 3 large
- Markers – 8 basic colors; LARGE; washable type; not felt tip style (Crayola style)
- Paper – loose-leaf, wide-ruled lines, with holes (no college ruled lines)
- Pencil Case – small, any type (not as large as an art box)
- Pencils – 10 #2 standard pencils w/ erasers
- Pens – 2 red
- Ruler – must have centimeters and inches and be 12 inches in length
- Scissors
- 2 Spiral bound notebooks – single subject
- Tissues – 2 large boxes

GRADES 5 AND 6

- Art Box (8 x 11 inches)
- Backpack (large enough to accommodate binder and several books)
- Bible – King James Version
- 1 three-ring binder - 1 inch
- Colored pencils (at least 12 basic colors)
- 1 Container of disinfectant wipes (ex. Clorox)
- 5 Pocket Dividers (for binder)
- 2 Dry erase markers – black (replace as necessary)
- Dry erase eraser
- Erasers – two large pink style
- Folders – 2 folders with pockets (plastic folders are highly recommended)
- Glue Sticks – 3 large
- Graph Paper – at least 150 sheets
- Markers – 8 basic colors; LARGE; washable type; not felt tip style (Crayola style)
- Paper – standard loose-leaf with holes (no college ruled lines)
- Pencil Case – small, any type (not as large as an art box)
- Pencils – 10 #2 standard pencils w/ erasers
- Pens - 5 blue or black; 2 red
- Ruler – must have centimeters and inches and be 12 inches in length
- Scissors
- 1 Spiral bound notebooks – single subject
- Tissues – 2 large boxes

GRADES 7 - 12

- Assignment Notebook
- Bible – King James Version
- 1 three-ring binder for all English classes, 7th and 8th grade Math
- 4 dividers for English binder
- 2-pocket folder
- Colored Pencils – 7/8 History
- Graph Paper – Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, and Advanced Math
- Paper – standard loose leaf with holes (no college ruled lines)
- Pencils – 5 #2 pencils w/erasers
- Pens – 2 blue or black; 2 red
- Protractor and Compass – all math classes
- Calculator – TI-30 series scientific calculator can be used for all math and science classes
- PE Uniforms – Non-marking gym shoes are required; uniforms must be purchased through the Academy Office and will be billed to student's account.
- Tissues – 2 large boxes

Note: 7-12th graders will need to cover their hardcover books. Paper or cloth covers may be used. Students are expected to maintain the covers in good condition and to replace them when necessary. Book covers should have only the name of the book and the student's name written on them and should be free from pictures, slogans, etc.

PLEASE NOTE (ALL GRADE LEVELS)

- **Students should bring all supplies to the Required Orientation Open House on Friday, August 16.**
- Please label all items with the student's name and grade. Permanent marker works best.
- Folders, notebooks, backpacks, lunchboxes, book covers, and clothing should not display questionable cartoon, videogame, television, or movie characters.
- All supplies must be replenished when necessary. Students are expected to maintain the number of pens, pencils, etc., so they are prepared for class.
