

PLEASE NOTE (ALL GRADE LEVELS)

- **Students should bring all supplies to the Required Orientation Open House on Friday, August 15.**
- Non-marking gym shoes are required for PE and recess when in the gymnasium. These shoes may be left at school.
- **All items labeled with the student's name and grade. Permanent marker works best.**
- Folders, notebooks, backpacks, lunchboxes, and book covers should not display questionable cartoon, videogame, television, or movie characters.
- All supplies must be replenished when necessary. Students are expected to maintain necessary pens, pencils, etc., so they are prepared for class.

K3, K4, AND K5
